Whole School Camp Out

On Friday 27th May we will be holding our first whole school camp-out. Our aim is for this to be a fun and memorable activity that pupils will enjoy and remember.

This will be open to all children and their families, including older/younger siblings who do not attend Woore School. At least one parent must stay over night with their children. Parents will have complete responsibility for the safety and behaviour of their children during the camp-out.

Parents will need to bring their own tents and sleeping equipment. Food will not be available to purchase, however barbeque facilities will be available for those who wish to bring their own sausages/ burgers etc. Hot water will be available to make tea/coffee and hot chocolate. Please bring with you all food items that you may require for the evening and for morning breakfast. Toasters will be available in the morning for breakfast. Don't forget plates and cups!

We plan to section off part of the school field for playing rounders/cricket etc and the rest of the field will be for pitching the tents. The playground can be used for tennis. The children will be able to use the forest school area and toast marshmallows by the fire which will be supervised by a member of staff (don't forget your marshmallows). The evening will end with story time in the shelter for younger pupils. A schedule is listed below:

4.00 onwards-Families arrive and set up tents

4.00 onwards-Ball games, children and adults

5.00-7.00 Barbeque facilities

6.00-7.30 Toasting Marshmallows in the forest school area

8.00 Story time under the shelter (younger pupils)

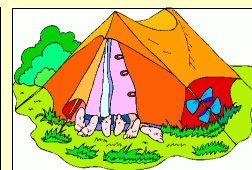
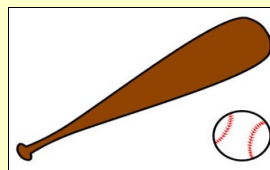
9.00 Ball games finish, pupils prepare to settle down
