Administering medicines in School

Following a recent review in our medicines policy, school will only administer medicines which are prescribed by a doctor or for the use of Calpol or Ibuprophen as directed for pain relief. All requests for medicine administration must be made by completing a form which is available from the school office. All medicines must be named with your child's name and be within date. Medicines for other reasons such as hayfever must be taken outside of the school day. Please refer to our 'Administering Medicines Policy' which is available on the school website. Could I remind parents to ensure all inhalers including spare inhalers which we keep on site are still within their use by date.
