Our Forest School Sessions will begin next Tuesday 15th September for all children. Children in Class 3 will have sessions fortnightly and sessions for other classes will be weekly. 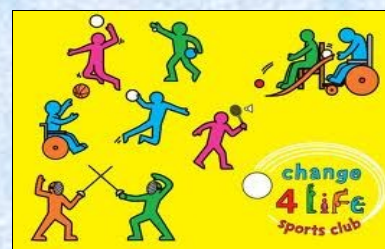
