### Musical instrument Tuition

I have been making enquiries about musical instrument tuition within school which would be provided by Shropshire Music Service. There is a range of tuition available for a wide range of instruments. If parents are interested in tuition within a small group then a weekly cost would be charged (approx. £7.50 group of 6 pupils) I would like to gauge an interest in this so that we can make any necessary arrangements for the terms ahead. If groups were larger, the smaller the cost and if they were smaller, the larger the cost. Some of these instruments can be hired from the music service at an additional charge (with exception of piano/keyboard, guitar, drums). At school we have 2 keyboards, a piano and a guitar which can be used by pupils. Some of the instruments on offer are listed below:

**Piano/keyboard, string (e.g. violin, cello, double bass, guitar), woodwind, brass (e.g. saxophone, trombone, trumpet, French horn etc.), Ukulele**

### **NOTICE TO PARENTS/CARERS SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS 2017/18**

Shropshire Council, as admission authority for community and controlled schools in Shropshire, is conducting a consultation exercise on School Admission Arrangements for 2017/18. The Council is simultaneously co-ordinating a consultation exercise for own admission authority schools, such as academies, whose governing bodies are responsible for setting their admission arrangements and who wish to make changes to those arrangements. We wish to notify all parents/carers that the consultation is now underway for a period of 6 weeks up until 29 January 2016.

In summary the proposed changes are as follows:

- Changes to the local authority's designated catchment area at secondary transfer for Craven Arms residents. This would result in the Stokesay Primary catchment area being shared between Ludlow CE School and Church Stretton School. (Please see [www.shropshire.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.shropshire.gov.uk/schooladmissions) for more information and an illustrative map.)
- The Academy Trusts of Idsall School and Oldbury Wells are proposing to add children of staff members to their oversubscription criteria.
- Lacon Childe School is also proposing to add children of staff to their oversubscription criteria, as well as prioritising applications from children who are transferring from any of the Trust's primary schools.
- Market Drayton Infant School have proposed to include criteria for children whose siblings are on roll at the fellow trust school, Market Drayton Junior School.
- Martin Wilson School in Shrewsbury is consulting on a proposal to reduce their published admission number (PAN) from 34 to 30.
