We are now nearly at the end of our swimming sessions (just one more week). This year we signed up for the School Swimming Charter which has been developed with the Amateur Swimming Association to provide high quality school swimming. The award scheme is based on the Fundamental Movement Skills in Physical literacy and helps develop the necessary aquatics skills to enable good swimming technique and also teaches water safety. We have been fortunate to be able to have more staff on the poolside with swimming experience to help with our lessons, thanks to Mrs Roberts and Helen being available.

All the children who have been swimming have been given a Water Safety leaflet and a worksheet to complete. These are part of the awards and we would ask if these could be returned as soon as possible. For each award achieved a sticker will be added to their Swimming Passport which will be kept throughout the child's time at Woore School and when they leave they can take the passport with them to show their swimming achievements. Certificates and badges will be available at the end of our 10 swimming sessions and a letter will be sent home explaining how these can be obtained.
