

## **Pupils and Parents Expectations for Remote Learning**

### **Pupils working remotely at home are expected to:**

- Follow the government guidance and complete a minimum of 3 hours of learning per day
- Be contactable during the school day – although they may not always be in front of a device the entire time
- Complete work to the deadline set by teachers to the best of their ability
- Seek help if they need it, from their teachers or teaching assistants
- Alert teachers if they're not able to complete work through Seesaw or Teams meetings
- Attend 'live sessions' through TEAMS, wherever possible

### **Staff can expect parents with children learning remotely to:**

- Encourage their child to complete their remote learning
- Offer guidance and support to their child, but encourage independence as far as possible
- Make the school aware if their child is sick or otherwise can't complete work
- Seek help from the school if they need it regarding any aspect of their child's learning
- Be respectful when making any complaints or concerns known to staff
- Understand that staff may contact you if they notice your child has not been engaging sufficiently with remote learning (in accordance with the DFE guidance)
